This chart, showing the academic year pattern approved by Senate on 18 Feb 2004, is the first published version. Some details, as marked in the key, have yet to be determined: these are the dates of award ceremonies, of supplementary assessments, and of rag day.

Minor modification made on 11 Aug 2004 to show the dates for supplementary assessment at the end of the 2004/05 academic year (weeks commencing 29 Aug 2005 and 5 Sep 2005).

Modified on 21 Jul 2005 to show the finalized winter award ceremony dates, Tue 6 & Wed 7 Dec 2005, and PROVISIONAL summer ceremony dates, Tue 4 - Thu 6 Jul 2006 (subsequently finalized).

Modified on 29 Oct 2005 to show Rag Day on Wed 1 Mar 2006, as agreed by Senate on 26 Oct 2005.
